





Dr. Robert R. Slater, Jr. Named 2024 Blair Filler Lifetime Achievement Award Recipient

At the recent Western Orthopaedic Association (WOA) Annual Meeting in Huntington Beach, the WOA proudly recognized Robert R. Slater, Jr., MD, FACS, as the 2024 recipient of the prestigious Blair Filler Lifetime Achievement Award. This distinguished award was established in honor of Dr. Blair Filler, whose enduring commitment to orthopaedic research, education, and leadership exemplifies the WOA's values.



The Blair Filler Lifetime Achievement Award celebrates individuals who, like Dr. Filler, have made profound contributions to the field of orthopaedics through leadership, service, education, and their commitment to excellence. Dr. Filler's career has been a benchmark of tireless service, exceptional mentorship, and dedication to advancing orthopaedic care. His leadership has significantly elevated the WOA, the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons (AAOS), and countless other organizations at the local, regional, and national levels.

Dr. Slater's career mirrors this legacy. A graduate of Stanford University and the University of Wisconsin-Madison School of Medicine, Dr. Slater completed his surgical and orthopaedic residency at the University of North Carolina-Chapel Hill, where he received the Nathan Womack Award as the top graduating chief resident. Following his hand and upper extremity fellowship at UC Davis, Dr. Slater served on the UC Davis faculty before establishing a highly respected solo practice in Folsom, California, dedicated to treating upper extremity disorders. His ongoing contributions to orthopaedic surgery extend beyond his practice; he has been a driving force in founding the Western Orthopaedic Foundation, served as Past President of the Western Orthopaedic Association (2017) and the Western Orthopaedic Foundation (2024), and is currently First Vice President of the California Orthopaedic Association.

Throughout his career, Dr. Slater has exemplified leadership in orthopaedic education and advocacy, advancing orthopaedic practice and promoting mentorship within the profession. His commitment to orthopaedics, coupled with his passion for service, exemplifies the spirit of the Blair Filler Lifetime Achievement Award.

Please join us in congratulating Dr. Bob Slater on this well-deserved honor. His dedication to the WOA and the orthopaedic community continues to inspire us all.

The WOF also provides Resident Travel Awards to help pay the expenses of selected presenters at the WOA Annual Meeting, another way the WOF supports the next generation of orthopaedic surgeons.
